*Plaques are 10" x 10" and manufactured from aluminum alloys with flint hardness to give them a scratch resistant surface. The finish is a bronze background with gold colored lettering.*

*\* Plaques are available with two options for mounting at no additional charge: double sided tape for mounting on any hard, smooth surface and "blind tapped" or "stud mount" which includes threaded bolts that require drilling into the mounting surface and securing the plaque with an epoxy or other type of adhesive. A "hanging cleat" or "z-bracket" is also available for an additional charge which allows for easy removal of the plaque. This is the least secure method of mounting. For diagrams of the blind tapped and hanging cleats, see second sheet of order form below.*

# MOUNT TYPES FOR HISTORIC PLAQUES

## Double Sided Tape


Double Sided Tape is to be used for mounting on any hard, smooth surface

## Stud Mount



## Blind Tapped (or Stud Mount)

Blind Tapped includes threaded bolts that require drilling into the mounting surface and securing the plaque



## Z-Bracket

## Stucco "Hanging Cleats" aka "Z-brackets"

A "hanging cleat" or "Z-bracket" is also available for an extra \$20 charge which allows for easy removal of the plaque. The latter is also the least secure method of mounting.
