**The plaques are available in two types of mounting, double sided tape for mounting on any hard, smooth surface, and “blind tapped,” which includes threaded bolts that require drilling into the mounting surface and securing the plaque with an epoxy or other type of adhesive. A “hanging cleat” or “z-bracket” is also available which allows for easy removal of the plaque. The latter is also the least secure method of mounting. Double Sided Tape

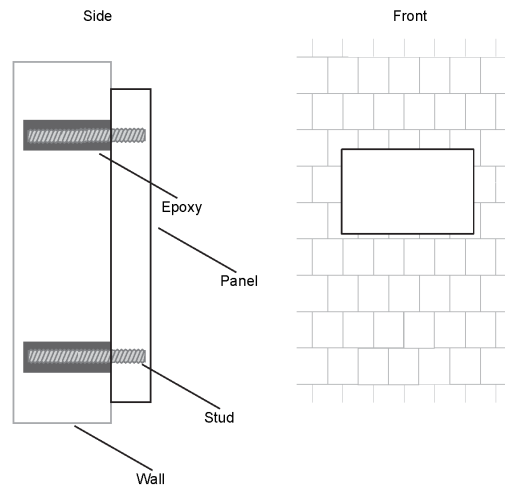
Double Sided Tape is to be used for mounting on any hard, smooth surface

Stud Mount



Blind Tapped (or Stud Mount)

Blind Tapped includes threaded bolts that require drilling into the mounting surface and securing the plaque



Z-Bracket

Stucco "Hanging Cleats" aka "Z-brackets"

A "hanging cleat" or "Z-bracket" is also available for an extra \$20 charge which allows for easy removal of the plaque. The latter is also the least secure method of mounting.
